- Finances and membership (John)

 - Members gained: 1 in March (for 1 month only)

New Business

- New Board Member?
 - Myranda interested. Board should discuss
 - o Board says yes! Interim board position approved until elections.
- Create plan for next board elections
 - Election should happen in May, for a June 1st term.
 - We should email the membership in April to ask for volunteers
 - Can be submitted on paper to red Dues box, or email to board@thebodgery.org.
- Reduce cost for PayPal dues?
 - Eliminate \$2 fee to pay by PayPal?
 - Tabled for now.
 - What about a discount for recurring setup?
 - Not now
 - o Or 6-month and 12-month discounts?
 - 6 months = 5% off, 12 months = 10% off
 - You can get a pro-rated refund, but the paid months will be calculated at the regular rate.
 - This works for any form of payment (paypal, cash, check)
 - Square is "working on" recurring payments. Interest expressed in using Square once they appear (in addition to PayPal)

- Use Square now as a PayPal alternative? Can at least do payments even if they're not automatic.
- Should the Bodgery grant Chris eternal use of CNC Router?
 - Not a member, but has worked diligently on getting it running.
 - Board voted yes
- **Tool Drive** (April 23 & 30)
 - Flyer made, partners agreed, promotion plan ideas
 - o Donation pad send graphics to Karen to print
 - Email to Trent/Rebecca to post at libraries
- 3-phase Drill Presses have been offered to us
 - They are willing to deliver it for free
 - We can store them on pallet racks, but will need a forklift to put them there.
 We'll also need an engine hoist to get it off the delivery truck
 - Board votes yes and thanks
- Extra storage on pallet racks
 - \$20 for uppers, \$30 for lowers? Membership had zero input last month.
 - Board votes yes.
- Static IP created for Bodgery server
 - Timm will create a doc explaining (logging in to Security Cameras and RFID system) for G-docs Board Business folder.
 - Did this happen?

- Board wants to build a sign for the front window, saying "The Bodgery" instead of "Open", and it'll be whenever dark.
- Alex volunteered to make a street sign, solar powered, with rope lights. Spend money on materials?
 - \$14 solar rope lights, scrounged wood, acrylic donated by Karen.
 - Board says yes.

• Metalshop request for tools:

- Beam clamp, chain fall, shackle, lifting strap. Dangerous to lift heavy tools/items with just our backs.
 - Raise money through classes?
 - Mike and Karen both contemplating workshops.
 - No word on workshops. Board not willing to buy this tool at this time. After emergency fund completed, we'll put it on the 'buy list'

• Woodshop request for tools:

- o Dust collection for shop. Need: 6"/4" pvc for runs, joint pieces, size adapters
 - Super Dust Deputy on sale at Menards for \$150
- We have some flexible hose on hack rack (move it?) from Karen
- Board willing to spend \$100 on dust collection, we'll fund raise for the rest.
 James willing to donate.
- Lengthy discussion about grade of blade for table saw. Board decided it would be best to purchase a basic quality blade. (~\$25)
