

Treasurer's Report

Member level composition

Current members as of 2/14: active members 320: includes: 1 Patron, 165 Regular, 22 six-month, 14 twelve-month, and 2 six-month students. It also includes these discounted rates: 30 Students, 56 Seniors, 9 Starving Hackers, and 18 family/spouse. We added 32 new members in the last 30 days, but there are 24 members with overdue renewals and 12 lapsed members.

Studio Update

Notes:

- -- 16.4 Studios rented in February for \$2050,
- -- 3 available studios: one in classroom, two in big shop.
- -- Wait list: 4 waiting for shop studios; 3 for clean room/electronics; three additional members on the "post-Covid" waitlist
- -- Board tentatively decided to wait for annex/layout decisions before releasing vacated studios.

Studio Update - Jay went through and formally asked renters and the wait list for studio (count up with notes)

Member Input and Discussion (10 minutes)

- Brian will be becoming more active in a month, after second COVID shot CONGRATS
- Older woodshoppers are waiting for the two week period and we may see an influx after that
- Ron: have we ever as a fundraiser had a sponsorship from a company. Two kinds of membership people vs. businesses supporting.
 - We did have Google purchase a set of memberships for sponsorships for the first two or three years
- Gear wall for sponsoring size of gear based on how much donated and gives vendors a way to get in front of an audience
- The sawstop the Bodgery is paying for half of it because Jim is ready to order. They have almost 1600 do we pay the balance for what's due? The board will pay UP TO a specific amount.
- Bathrooms are not as clean as they used to be in the past cleaning contract (later on agenda)

Priority Business

COVID

- Wisconsin 7-day average new cases as of today is 659 and has steadily decreased over the last month.
- For reference, the Wis 7-day avg new case peaked at 6564 on 11/18. The previous peak was 930 on 7/26.
- New members are capped at 10 per week
- Classes are still members-only or virtual
- Still no public nights

Annex Expansion

- This will be a lease amendment, adding 7,840 sq ft to our existing 13,590 sq ft lease
- Time estimate after LOI agreement: Paperwork 1-2 months, Findorff 2-3 months
- LOI and buildout quote are back from Rabin (again)

Outstanding clarification - we think we're on the same page, but want to get it in writing

Facility Planning

- Bill has completed some preliminary analyses
 - Where the woodshop expands is the first decision because that decision drives other decisions
- Board members reviewed preliminary analyses on 2/16
- Area captains to review preliminary analyses on 2/23
- Moving costs a report can be run in Xero

 - Change WA before May 21 to a lower tier (50=Free, 100=\$48/mo, 250=\$60/mo)

- Board voted 6 to 0 on 1/31/21 in Slack to contract with Occupy Madison Inc for cleaning
 - Added to these minutes 4/26/21 from 'board_20-21-archived' 1/31/21 (added by Mark P):

- QUOTE: Original motion: Employ Occupy Madison Inc for cleaning services. Compensation would be in the form of four Bodgery memberships. Amendment: Compensation would shall be based on paying OM for 2 hours a week at the rate of \$25 per hour plus free membership for workers.
- Comment: This is approximately \$200 per month (\$25/hr, 2 hr/wk, 4wk/mo).
- Purchase of Hossfeld metal bender, approved, funded, purchased, installation essentially complete
- Purchase of 2nd Saw Stop, approved, funded, purchase is in progress
- Got in touch with the Voit Farm project (<u>www.savethefarm.net</u>)
 - Possible location for Bodgery 4.0
 - Should still look for other possibilities; it's good to have options
 - Our lease is up in 4.5 years, which is not too early to start
 - Board approved for us to go on their list of supporters
- Making Monday nights open to everyone, not just members
 - Use a generated meeting ID instead of the personal meeting DI
