• Spending on Tools

- We've spent money on a few things (security cameras, kitchen sink upgrade, etc), and have a wishlist. Milwaukee MS recently posted a used TIG welder for sale. Might be a good time to brainstorm a draft schedule for when we start buying tools (if a deal emerges maybe set a cost range for each one?), and which ones are ok'd.
 - Angle iron for metal lathe bench (\$50), TIG welder (\$400)?
 - Board had wide-ranging discussion, with conflicting opinions.
 - It was agreed that the focus of savings should go to the "Contingency Fund" (\$10k) until that is amount is met. At that point, the board (and community) should consider savings funds, like space expansion fund, tool expansion fund, etc.
 - Approved to move \$6,000 to that fund immediately.
 - Ken feels strongly that we should come up with a budget for a monthly amount to be added to the Contingency Fund, as well as Tool Improvement/Expansion Fund, Space Expansion fund, etc.
