- Finances and membership (John)
 - Current members: 41, including 1 desk rental, and 2 scholarships.

New Business

- Extra storage on pallet racks
 - We should email members so they know it's available.
 - \$20 for uppers, \$25-\$30 for lowers? Ask membership for input.
- Static IP created for Bodgery server
 - What's the process for logging in to Security Cameras and RFID system? (So it's not all dependent on Timm)
 - Timm will create a doc explaining it for G-docs Board Business folder.
- Efficient use of shop space
 - Are we running out of room (for tools)?
 - o Loft? Probably not: expensive for materials, lots of labor, permits, etc.
 - Too early to think about expansion to 6000+ sq ft?
 - Not too early to ponder, but board doesn't think we should actually move until we hit 70-80 members, less if it's just expanding next door.

• Signage for front of building

- When arriving from Milwaukee side, no signage visible. Lighting would also be nice, as our Open Shops are during evenings.
- o Simple "Open" sign from Amazon (\$23)? Board says sure.
- The Open (webcam camera) switch could also send a signal when it's on/off, so another RasPi would have to check that signal and turn on/off the sign.
- Could also use that sign-based RasPi to run it on a timer. (less work to base it off the Open/Closed switch.)

• Build a sign? Karen willing to help, but not be the lead on it.

Carvey

- Do we need to charge a usage rate? For bit replacement, cut surface replacement, repairs, etc.
 - James says it's like table saw we just replace the bits/blades
 - Board agrees, says no charge.

• Demo new electronic guest sign-in form

- Looks great! It's website based, so can be run on any device. Three offers of a
 7" android tablet, none have arrived yet.
- o QR code for phone entries (when main unit is busy) will be added

• Guest tool usage policy

- If a guest is signed off on a tool, does a knowledgeable member have to be present?
 - It's challenging to have any sponsoring member know all the tools, so if a guest is signed off on the tool, we'll consider them able to use it without close supervision.
 - But, a member should be in the same area (esp shop side) while a guest is there - in case the guest has a heart attack/stroke, injures themselves, has a question, makes a big mess, or otherwise violates our rules
 - We should figure out a way to ensure that at least 2 members will be at Open Shops, one on each side, to allow a fully "Open Shop"
 - Let's send a clarifying email to the members on this policy. (JE will)
